The award is named after William Edwards Deming, an American academic widely credited with improving production in the United States during the Cold War -- and recognized for his unprecedented efforts to maximize production processes in Japan. Deming is widely credited for helping that country develop its reputation for quality products that has positioned it as a global economic power.

According to the W. Edwards Deming web site: "The Deming Application Prize is an annual award presented to a company that has achieved distinctive performance improvements through the application of Total Quality Management (TQM).
