## Consideration for the Environment in Our Products

Yaskawa environmental considerations reach across all stages of the product life cycle.

Yaskawa introduced life cycle assessment (LCA) in 2006 at the planning and designing stages of a product. LCA aims for products and a business model that can best reduce the environmental load throughout the product's life cycle, from its very beginnings to the end of its useful life. As a result, you may notice a reduction in the amount of instruction media packaged with certain products<sup>1</sup>.

In fall of 2013, paper instructions that ship with variable speed drive products were reduced by up to **70%**. Most noticeable is the replacement of a printed manual (usually titled "Quick Start Guide") with two much smaller printed documents by the titles of "Quick Start Procedure" (formerly called "Cheat Sheet") and "Safety Precautions." Refer to the table below for a description of these new instructions packaged with the product.

Subsequently, in fall of 2014, Yaskawa began eliminating CDs (digital media) that ship with variable speed drive products.

While Yaskawa's strategy has changed regarding instruction media that ships with these products, essential instructions in reduced paper format will be included, and full length instructions (both printed versions and CDs) can be ordered free of charge.
